the best Powder runs in the Ziller Valley

The King Lines are the most terrific lines on the Hintertux glacier. These are high-alpine freeride runs, which lead partially across glaciers and exposed ridges into hidden valleys. In some areas, you might even have to rappel down steep couloirs in order to reach untouched slopes. Descents up to 2000 m through the beautiful, high-alpine landscape of the Ziller Valley Alps will be an exciting part of this unforgettable day.

You must be a confident skier or snowboarder and steep slopes shouldn't cause you any problems. You would like a mountain guide as a reliable partner to show you the best runs

Tour guided by a UIAGM mountain & ski guide
Selection of ski areas with the best and safest conditions
Rental avalanche transceiver, backpack, probe, & shovel
Ortovox ABS Airbag backpack with back protector

Lift ticket
Taxi fees

Minimum number of participants:

1 – 6 people per mountain guide
