

Powder skiing course

The Ziller Valley with its variety of off piste skiing in mid-winter and the Hintertux glacier with its snow guarantee are ideal areas for our deep-snow skiing courses. The goal of the course is to ski safely and confidently in deep snow and alpine terrain. Lifts are taking us back to the top so we can concentrate completely on powder skiing. This will give us more opportunities to do technique exercises, quickly getting you close to your goal of enjoying glorious deep-snow skiing.

Program 3 days:

Day 1:

We meet at 08:30 am at our Alpine school, where the mountain guide is waiting to welcome you and to go through the program. Together you will check the equipment: set up, skis and boots. Followed by ski technique training on the slopes and off-piste.

Day 2:

Downhill runs with main focus on deep snow skiing - adapted to skills and conditions. A video analysis will help us refine and improve our ski technique.

Day 3:

Variant downhill runs in easy and moderate deep snow conditions. Various exercises for skiing different types of snow. The course ends approx. at 16:30 pm.

Important information ...

Requirements:

You can ski safely on all slopes up to 35° and you will be fit for a full skiing day up to 6 hours.

Included:

3 days organization and guided tour by a state certified UIAGM mountain guide
Rental avalanche transceiver device, probe, shovel
Teaching material: Safety Academy
Downhill technique & tactics
Area selection according to current avalanche & snow conditions

Not included:

Overnight stay
Lift ticket

Minimum number of participants:

4 - 8 people per mountain guide

Meeting point:

08:30 am at our Alpine school Mountain Sports, Hollenzen 75, 6290 Mayrhofen

Weather:

Weather and snow conditions can be extreme in the mountains. Two till three days before we arrive, we will check the current weather forecast and the conditions in the area we are going. You will be informed immediately if there are any changes to the plan.
