.. Tours in the East Alps reminding of the West Alps

The Ziller Valley Alps present an impressive and very diversified ski tour landscape. With the steep rock faces of the main ridge of the Alps, the imposing gullies and the long and steep cirques you are strongly reminded of the endless descents of the West Alps. There are also easy ski tours in this area, which lead through sparse, not too steep forests and therefore suited for less experienced tourers.

The booking becomes legally valid upon receipt of your registration by Mountain Sports. If the execution of the tour is uncertain due to the minimum number of participants not yet reached, we will inform you immediately.

Payment must be made up to 20 days before the start of the tour. Exception: Tours with separate regulations.
